

## **MEETING NOTICE**

### **HEALTH CARE JUSTICE ACT PUBLIC HEARING ADEQUATE HEALTH CARE TASK FORCE 14<sup>th</sup> CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT**

The 14<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Public Hearing of the Adequate Health Care Task Force under the Health Care Justice Act will be held on Wednesday, December 14, 2005, at Aurora Christian High School (Auditorium), 2255 Sullivan Road, Aurora, Illinois, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

To park near the Auditorium, turn north on Bowman Drive from Sullivan Road. Then make the second right turn into the parking lot. The main entrance to the auditorium is located under the blue awning.

Individuals who wish to testify about access to quality, affordable health care may sign-up to do so at the hearing. Individuals will each be given three minutes to testify, and will testify in the order in which they sign-up.

Those who wish to submit written testimony may do so in one of three ways –
