- 1. The meeting was called to order at 9:35am the minutes were reviewed and approved by a motion presented by Ed Hirsch, MD and seconded by Urmil Chaudry, MD
- 2. The meeting was closed at 9:45am by a motion from Howard Strassner, MD seconded by Dennis Crouse, MD in order to discuss materials presented by Northwest Community Hospital this is an 18 month follow-up to their change in designation from a Level II with extended neonatal capabilities to a level III perinatal facility
- 3. The meeting was reopened at 11:15am by a motion from Lenny Gibeault and seconded by Dennis Crouse, MD – the following motion was presented and voted on by the committee with 9 supporting the motion and 1 abstention:
  - MOTION

The hospital is not providing the expected surgical services for a Level III and therefore will need to implement the following:

- ✓ The hospital will submit a detailed surgical service implementation plan within 90 days to IDPH, outlining the timetable and actions needed to provide a full scope of neonatal surgery services on-site, normally expected at a level III facility.
- ✓ If a neonatal surgical case cannot be performed at Northwest Community Hospital, the delivery of the neonate should occur at an institution with the appropriate resources

- ✓ In addition, adequate documentation of the unmet expectation requiring transfer of the mother should be outlined in detail
- ✓ Quarterly reports will be sent to the Administrative Perinatal Center and IDPH, detailing the listing of surgeries occurring at Northwest Community Hospital, a list of the mothers/neonates transfer out for surgery and the rationale and unmet expectations documented – updates on plan implementation will also be included
- ✓ Northwest Community Hospital will appear before the committee in 1 year
- 4. The work plan for the committee was reviewed and the following updates were given:
  - a. St. John's, Missouri is scheduled for November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2012
  - b. South Suburban site visit was incomplete they are working with their Administrative Center to complete needed information before coming before the committees
- 5. The nominating committee is working to put together a slate of candidates for the election which will occur by mail over the summer
- 6. The meeting was closed at 11:35am for discussion of the Carle Foundation Hospital site visit and discussion of the request for change in network
- The meeting was opened at 12:25pm and a motion was presented by Dennis Crouse, MD and seconded by Janet Albers, MD: MOTION Carle Foundation Hospital shall be redesigned as a level III perinatal

institution at this time

A proposal was made to hold on the recommendation for change in network and provide an arbitrator/neutral individual to hear all sides of the request, gather appropriate information about the issue and make a recommendation to IDPH concerning this issue.
