No activity: No laboratory confirmed cases of influenza and no reported increase in cases of influenza like illness (ILI).

Sporadic: Small numbers of laboratory confirmed influenza cases or a single laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state.

<sup>2</sup>Local: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state. Regional: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least two but less than half the regions of the state.

Widespread: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI cases and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least half the regions in the state. <sup>3</sup>"Influenza like Illness" is defined as fever ≥ 100°F and cough and/or sore throat.

\*Threshold=3.66%
