Local: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state.

2Regional: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least two but less than half the regions of the state.

Widespread: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI cases and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least half the regions in the state.

³"Influenza like Illness" is defined as fever ≥ 100°F and cough and/or sore throat.

*Threshold=3.66%

**ILI data excluding the City of Chicago
